Our schools and our homes are situated in a parish. There are churches, schools, shops, clubs and other facilities in every parish. A parish priest or an administrator is in charge of the parish. He organises the events in the life of the parish. He visits the families and helps them with important occasions in their lives, such as baptisms, marriages and funerals. He usually has a team to help him in this work. This team may include a curate and members of the Parish Pastoral Council. What is the name of your parish?
